Training Report – Chuck Hentz

- **Fall Training Schedule** – Coaches filled in requested trainers and times. Age groups will train together,

- Club will not train more than 1 ½ . Strongly rec no team practice longer than 2 hours. Getting harder and harder to appease coaches request, trying our best to make schedules to get training and fields.
- Training Locations (SIUE Grass/Korte & 5thAve) Korte-Mon and Thursday nights.
- Trainers (John Becher, John Van Buskirk, Mark Ward, Jason Porter, EliteFt, Dave Fernandez and Chuck Hentz) Dave went to Vetta, no longer full time. John Becher and John Van buskirk, Heads Men’s Coach at McKendry. Elite FT everyone seemed to like him, prices reasonable.

Treasury Report-Chuck Hentz

- Treasurer's report-YOY 15-16 Document handed out. For the 10 months ended May 31,2016: Revenue \$206,000. Expenses \$274,148. Net fund balance change -\$68,072. This is not a true reflection of results due to accounting changes and calendar shifts in revenue and expenses. Adjusting for information, Net revenue is approximately, \$256,000 with expenses approximately, \$224,000 for a total FUND Balance increase of approximately \$\$22,000.
- GESKO 2016 Tournament Report- Overall tournament went well, profit \$10,000

Vice President-Rob Landers

- 3v3 Tournament -82 teams in tournament, had 61 last year, 33 % increase and a little bit revenue from concessions.
 - o Glen-Ed’s was the largest of 25 events around the nation for that day.
 - o Goal is to hit 100 next year.
- Those that want to play 3v3 in July, calendar is updated on website to click thru.
- Teams needing practice space can use SIUE but need to coordinate field use with Rob. 7-8:30 best time, but be sure to bring bug spray.

- Have a list of tournament partners that we want Glen-Ed teams to enter. You are welcome to collect extra fees and do additional tourneys. Look at 2015 Calendar and refer to dates, 2016 Calendar not up to date.
- Managers should be looking for player availability for tournaments. Sending out requests to players to find out availability.
- Make tournament hotel reservations ASAP. October tournaments should have hotel reservations by August 1st.
- **Most importantly, all conflict dates have to be in GotSoccer SLYSA event by July 12.**
 - Go into your team account. Go into Requests, and request that weekend off. You get 8 days off in Fall session.
 - Don't need to take off Friday, if you take off Saturday and Sunday, it will automatically give you Friday.
 - Teams may have SLYSA games on weeknights.
- Tournament fees- we will make payments for your all your tournaments if we are collecting your fees.
- Gotsoccer.com is our registration site
- Soccer.com is where we buy our uniforms and other club-branded merchandise.
 - Uniform order link comes in an email from uniform system. We have required stuff and optional stuff. Green set and white set are required.
 - One exception, the Dev team will have one set only to keep the cost down.
 - Order second pair of white socks is good idea to tell parents.
 - When we do the sizing, we have all the sizing in here and jot down sizes on uniform order pamphlet provided. Sock wise good idea to try on, and we have x-small back this year.
 - This is final year for uniforms we are currently wearing so we have new models next year. The ones we order this year, we may only use for one year. 50% chance have to buy new uniform next year.
 - All HS boys have to have things ordered by December. Current models start to become out-of-stock in January and may not be available.
 - New players-needs first/last name, email and number for them. 2-39 numbers
 - Managers go into team acct and print of game card that have player numbers on them so be sure to update and get them to match what's actually on uniform.
 - Yellow uniforms- coaches if you decide to go with 3rd optional set of uniforms must communicate to team. Cost is about \$32, some people like it for tourneys and can be used as home or away.
